Today you get your first look at the 2024 All Star Dance Class schedule. One thing that makes your class schedule look different this year is the fact that we have one extra room. Therefore, we are offering more classes some hours so you have more choices.

No one expects you to do a class every hour. In fact, we strongly recommend that you do not even think about doing that. Think of the camp schedule like you would an "All You Can Eat" Buffet. Everything on the buffet may look good but you know it will not be good for you if you try to eat it all. And, while all the classes will be good, too, you will actually get more out of camp of you carefully pick and choose what you think you would enjoy the most.

Having more choices may be frustrating because you want to take everything. But it is important to pick and choose those things that you think will help most with your dance development. If you aren't sure, ask your teacher at your home studio to go over the schedule with you to help you decide.

At All Star we use the self-selection process. You do not need to sign up in advance for the classes you want to take. You just show up on time at your preferred class and enjoy. Be sure to wear your camp badge. Your badge gains you entrance to all activities.

Some people ask if they have to take the same level for all of their classes. The answer is "absolutely not!" You may be a beginner in Viennese Waltz and, at the same time, be at the full bronze level in Cha Cha. For the best learning experience, be sure to take the appropriate level.

Why do we call this schedule tentative? Because things could possibly occur that would necessitate changes. For instance, a teacher could get injured and wouldn't be able to teach so we would need to switch who was teaching certain classes. But the schedule is pretty close to what you will have this summer. If changes are made we will try to let you know before camp.

There is a lot of information that we will be giving you about the schedule. But we don't want to overload you all at once. So, take a

look at what all we have planned for you, and we will get into details later.
