When going to a big event, a question that most of us have is, "Where will I sit?" In this newsletter, we are giving you a heads up on the seating arrangements for Sunday night as well as the seating for the rest of the week.

Sunday Night Seating

Camp kicks off with a dance party Sunday evening at 7 pm. There is no meal served on Sunday, so please eat before you come. We understand that travel plans may prevent you from arriving in time to be in the ballroom right at 7 pm but we encourage you to join us whenever you can.

All newcomers, on Sunday night, will have a reserved seat at one of the tables adjacent to the dance floor. This ensures that all newcomers have a front row seat for their first dance camp experience. There will be camp ambassadors at each table to help answer questions.

If this will be your first year at camp and you are coming to camp with friends who have previously attended and you want to sit with them rather than in newcomer seating, just let Jill know.

All the tables on Sunday night that are not reserved for newcomers will be open seating.

Dinner Seating Monday Through Thursday

It is our goal for everyone to have a comfortable place to sit for dinner. Just as on a cruise ship, everyone will have an assigned table for dinner. As we've previously shared, you can organize a table with six or more people. However, that is not necessary to have a wonderful time.

Here are the answers to some common questions:

How will I know the table at which I am seated for dinner Monday - Thursday nights?

Each afternoon, Monday - Thursday, there will be a seating chart posted in the camp lobby right by the camp registration desk showing where your table is located. Be sure and check this seating chart each night as tables will be in different places throughout the week in order for each group to be seated close to the dance floor at least one night.

Where is the camp registration desk?

The camp registration desk is right outside the All Star Ballroom in the Convention Center in the Silver Star Hotel.

Will my table be in the same place each night?

Table placements will be different every night. Be sure and check the seating chart outside the ballroom each night to locate your table placement.

Do I have to stay at my table after dinner?

As dinner winds down and the party begins, it is ok to relocate if you wish.

Do I need to let Jill know if I want to sit with my spouse, partner or companion?

Spouses will be seated together automatically. However, if your companion, dance partner, or close friend has a different last name or mailing address, Jill may not know to seat you together. If you think there's any uncertainty, please email her with your seating preferences.

Reserving A Table for Dinner

Each dinner table seats 10 people. If you have a group of six or more, you can reserve a table. Simply email Jill with the name of your table and the names of those who should be seated at your table. If you have fewer than 10, additional campers will be assigned to your table to fill up the remaining seats.

Whether you reserve a table or not, you will have a place to sit.
