Jack & Jills Are So Much Fun!

At camp, we'll have three Jack & Jill dance competitions:

- Monday: Cha Cha
- Tuesday: Foxtrot
- Wednesday: West Coast Swing

In a Jack & Jill competition, dancers are randomly paired—leaders with followers—and the fun begins! Everyone dances in the first round, and a judge selects 12 couples to move on.

In the second round, those 12 couples dance again. This time, the judge chooses the top 6 couples to continue.

During the final round, the judge ranks the remaining couples from first to sixth place. But there's a twist—everyone watching (who's not dancing) gets to vote for their favorite couple, too! It's always exciting to see whether the judges and the audience pick the same winners.

Remember: Jack & Jill aren't about winning. They're a great opportunity to practice your lead-follow skills with new partners and have a blast doing it.

Things to Know About Classes

What class level should I choose?

You may switch from one level to another depending on your expertise in each dance. If you know fewer than five figures in a dance, you should choose Beginning Bronze. If you know six figures, but fewer than 13, then you may want to try Intermediate Bronze classes. If you know 13 or more figures in a dance, then you should choose Full Bronze. If you are an advanced dancer, you should choose Silver or Gold. If you aren't sure which to choose, it is a good idea to ask your teacher before camp or you can ask any of the teachers at camp and they will advise you.

How long are the classes?

At 8:15 each morning, we have a 30-minute exercise/warm up class taught by dance exercise specialist, Phillip Farley. Classes are taught at the beginning of each hour from 9 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Wednesday and until 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday. Each class is approximately 50 minutes in duration – 45 minutes for teaching and 5 minutes to video.

We encourage you to schedule breaks and to not try to do everything!

Where are the classes located?

Pearl River Resorts consists of two hotels that are connected by an enclosed, air-conditioned corridor. There are classrooms in both hotels.

Silver Star includes the All Star Ballroom, where our main parties will be, the Promenade, Rising Star and Stardust classrooms.

Golden Moon includes the VIP and Magnolia classrooms. The Magnolia classroom is used exclusively for private lessons, but not all private lessons are taught in Magnolia. If you have scheduled privates, you will receive a list of your lessons when you arrive at camp. Be sure to check the location of each lesson each time as the location may change based on what rooms are available.

You can still schedule private lessons when you arrive at camp. Just check at the camp desk to find out when your preferred instructor is available.

Classroom Etiquette

Please be respectful of your teacher and the other students. It is important for everyone to hear and to see the teacher throughout each class. Do not 'teach' in the classes. If someone asks you a question, request that they ask the teacher. If you or your partner are having trouble with something, it is very likely that others are as well. So, it helps everyone when we let the teacher teach, and we all listen without disruption. Thanks for remembering this!

Do couples have to change partners in the classes?

We strongly encourage you to rotate. We find that we all learn more when everyone participates in rotation during the classes. If you are strongly opposed to rotating, please let your teacher know at the beginning of class.

Video Policy

All Star Dance Camp does not produce a camp DVD. You are invited to video whatever material you would like to keep. In each class, the teacher will teach the first 45 minutes, then for the last five minutes the teacher will review what he/she just taught and allow you to video. You may also video your private lessons. Also, be sure to get a friend to video you in your routine class performances on Thursday night.

Please pack everything you need to capture the content you will want to take home. Remember extra storage space, cables and your recording devices.

What to Wear at Camp

While attending group classes during the day we recommend that you go for comfort. Most people wear garments that will stretch and shoes that lend themselves to dancing all day. We recommend that you wear practice shoes for classes.

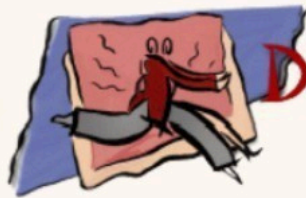
Parties
