# When You Arrive at Camp & Other Things That Are Good to Know

### Where Do I Sign In For Camp When I Arrive?

The camp registration desk is your headquarters while at camp and is the hub for all activity. It is located in the lobby of the Convention Center area in the Silver Star Hotel. This is where you will pick up your camp packet and your camp name badge, which is your passport to all of the All Star Dance Camp events.

You may also schedule massages, private lessons, and purchase All Star Gear at the camp desk. The desk will open on Sunday at 2 p.m. and will remain open until 7 p.m. Please stop by when you arrive to pick up your camp materials and your name badge.

On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday the desk will open at 8:30 a.m. and close at 6:30 p.m. On Thursday, the desk will open at 8:30 a.m. and close at 4:00 p.m. During the evening events, front desk personnel will be seated at a staff table. This will be the table closest to the entrance to the All Star Ballroom. If you have

questions or need help during the evening parties, there will always be someone on hand to help with your needs.

### **Badges**

Please wear your badges at all times. Your badge is your admission ticket to all the camp events. On Thursday night, please remember to turn in your badge when leaving the ballroom.



### **Seating at Welcome Party**

The party, held in the All Star Ballroom in the Silver Star Hotel, is a very important event.

All newcomers, on Sunday night, will have a reserved seat at one of the tables adjacent to the dance floor. This ensures that all newcomers have a front row seat for their first dance camp experience. There will be camp ambassadors at each table to help answer questions.

All the tables on Sunday night that are not reserved for newcomers will be open seating.

### **Dinner Seating Monday Through Thursday**

It is our goal for everyone to have a comfortable place to sit for dinner. Just as on a cruise ship, everyone will have an assigned table for dinner. Each afternoon, Monday - Thursday, there will be a seating chart posted in the camp lobby right by the camp registration desk showing where your table is located.

Be sure and check this seating chart each night as tables will be in different places throughout the week in order for each group to be seated close to the dance floor at least one night.

## Thursday Night

On Thursday evening, we will kick off the night by celebrating our own class performances - along with those of our fellow campers - as we showcase the routines we've worked on all week.

After dinner, the Pros will perform for us. First, we'll enjoy a Pro Rumba group routine, and later, we'll be entertained by our talented instructors as they perform a special show just for us. We encourage you to dress up for our final night, but please remember, if you're in a routine class, your attire should also be suited for your performance.

### **Encore Store**

If you would like to place gently-used dance wear in our Encore Store (our camp consignment shop), please bring those items with you. (Absolutely no shoes.) Our front desk staff will assist you in placing your dance clothes in the Encore Store.

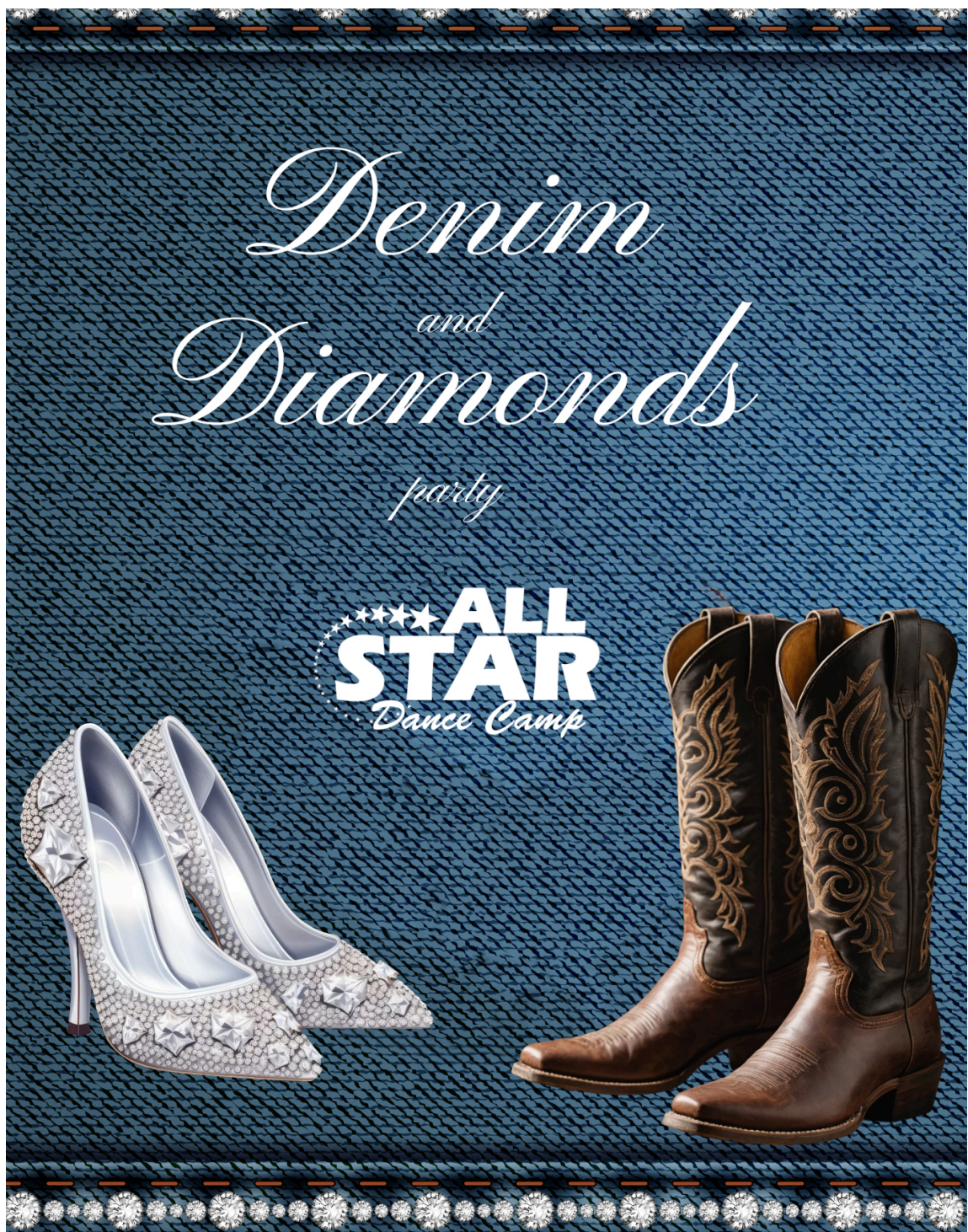
The Encore Store is exclusively for dance costumes and dance practice wear. . . Men's and Ladies'.

### **Here is how it works. . .**

- Bring your items to the camp desk. If you have them on hangers bring the hangers. If you don't, hangers will be provided for you.
- You will be given a hanger, if needed, and an envelope for each item.
- On the envelope there will be spaces for you to put your name, your phone number and your asking price. There is a hole in the envelope so you can slip the envelope over the hanger so it will stay with that item.
- If a person wants to purchase your item, they simply put their payment in the envelope and leave it at the camp desk for you. The people at the desk will text you to let you know you have an envelope or envelopes at the desk.
- At the end of camp, if you have unsold items, you can pick them up or, if you don't pick them up they will be donated to the youth dance program in Birmingham operated by Dueta Dance that provides prom dresses for home school youth.

### **Is alcohol allowed in the ballroom?**

As per our contract with Pearl River Resort, there is no alcohol allowed in the ballroom.
