What to Wear at Camp And Why It Matters!



At camp, one of the most fun (and smartest!) ways to upgrade your dance wardrobe is the Encore Store - our weeklong dance consignment shop where campers can buy and sell gently used dancewear.

Think about it... how many times have you looked at something in your closet and thought, I love this, but I probably won't wear it again? Maybe it's a performance dress, fringe pants, a sparkly top—or even tux pants (yes, gentlemen, bring items too!). Instead of letting those pieces sit unworn, bring them to camp and let someone else enjoy them.

And on the flip side—you never know what treasures you'll find. Many of our campers count on the Encore Store every year to discover something special for performances or classes.

How It Works

When you arrive at camp, simply bring your items to the camp desk at the entrance to the main ballroom in the Silver Star Convention Center.

You'll:

- Fill out an envelope with your name, item description, and price
- Attach it to the hanger
- And you're ready to sell!

We accept youth, ladies', and gentlemen's dancewear—but no shoes, please.

👉 Bottom line: bring things to sell... and leave room in your suitcase to take things home!



What to Wear to Group Classes

During the day, comfort is key.

Most campers wear what they would wear to group classes at their home studio.

Think:

- Stretchy, breathable clothing
- Practice wear that allows full movement
- Comfy dance shoes appropriate for all-day wear

We do ask that clothing be appropriate and not overly revealing. This is a family-friendly camp with all ages in attendance, and we want everyone to feel

comfortable - both in what they're wearing and what others are wearing.

Important (and appreciated by everyone):

- Ladies, when wearing skirts, always wear appropriate undergarments (we often call them “dance pants”—similar to cheer shorts or biker shorts)
- Tops should provide coverage and security for movement

And one more thing, said kindly but clearly, and this is for both ladies and gentlemen: Your partner is generally placing their hand under your arm on your side and back, so sleeves are appreciated by your partners. Sleeveless styles in group classes where dancers often get hot and sweaty can make that contact uncomfortable. A little fabric goes a long way in making your partner feel at ease—so please be thoughtful and considerate.

What To Wear for Parties & Evenings

One of the highlights of camp is dressing for the nightly themes—this is where the fun really comes to life!

Sunday Night – Welcome Dance Party

Casual and comfortable... but if you enjoy dressing to theme, this year's colors are red and black to kick off our Music in Motion theme. If you can either go with the colors or come up something that gives off a music vibe - or both - have at it!

Monday Night – Costume Contest

Theme: Move to the Music

This is your chance to be creative, fun, and expressive. Costumes are optional—but if you love to participate, this is your night to shine!

Tuesday Night – Black & White Ball

Classic. Elegant. Always a favorite. Black and white never misses.

Wednesday Night – Neon Nights

Think bright, bold, glowing, electric. The brighter, the better!

Thursday Night – Performances & Finale

Wear what is appropriate for your group routines or performances. This is a polished, showcase evening.

Gentlemen – Pack Smart

Always bring:

- Black dress pants

- White dress shirts
- Black dress shirts
- Black ties

You will use them—guaranteed.

Ladies – A Few Helpful Guidelines For Performance Wear

- For Smooth: longer, more flowing styles
- For Rhythm: shorter, more playful/sassy styles
- Doing both? Just split the difference and you'll be fine!

Final Thought

Clothing at camp isn't about being perfect - it's about being comfortable, appropriate, and ready to fully enjoy the experience. Come prepared to move, to sweat, to sparkle a little... and most of all, to have a fantastic week.

And at camp, the most important thing to know is our overriding motto: Rule #1, Have Fun!
