The RMYSP is a special project of the Jackson (TN) Ballroom Dance Club. The scholarship committee consists of Elizabeth Edwards, chair; Caren Vitell and Kem Overby.



In addition to memorials for Ron, many campers have chosen to make donations to honor or in memory of other campers.

Mariana Rivas Varela


